

#### FEAR NOTHING BUT GOD HIMSELF

Fear is one of the strongest, most primal emotions and motivating forces there is. Whether it is the fear of death, fear of the unknown, or fear of what others may say, many live their lives in constant fear. The devil knows this and uses fear to cripple would-be saints. He throws darkness across our path and suddenly we are frozen from fear. He uses fear as a breeding ground for hate, shame, and discouragement.
