The great preacher and evangelist Charles Spurgeon and his wife kept chooks in their backyard. The chooks were prolific layers and Charles and his wife used to sell the extra eggs around the neighbourhood. Many folk thought they were mean for not just giving the eggs away. But what people didn't know was that the egg money was given to a couple of poor widows to supplement their meagre income. Herein lies an example for us all.

There are many ways a person can serve God and their fellow man at church. You can be involved as an elder, deacon, Sabbath School teacher, or in Pathfinders, Adventurers, Cell Group, Recipe Club, Social Committee, Newsletter, Lego Club, Treasury, or personal ministries. Many folk faithfully serve in this way week after week. However, "the monotony of our service for God needs to be broken up. Every church member should be engaged in some special service for the Master" YSRP 147.

Often this will be something only you and the Lord know about – like Charles Spurgeon and his wife. Use your imagination and make it fun.
