THANK YOU LORD

As a child, we were taught to show clear and visible gratitude when given a gift. We were taught to smile, make eye contact, say thank you, and give the giver a hug (where appropriate). Even if it wasn't what we wanted, the giver had made an effort, and it was the thought that counts.

In today's entitled world, people are focused on their rights. Even when given gifts or envelopes, they assume that because it's their birthday or Christmas, of course they should receive gifts! Life has become a struggle to stay ahead, and we have become less grateful, less thankful.

Why is this a problem? Because how we live our material lives spills over into our spiritual lives. We are less adept at recognising blessings, and we show less gratitude to God than ever before.
