SING ME A SONG

When we study the Bible we learn that the only thing we take to heaven is our character – who we really are on the inside when no one is looking. It makes sense then that what we won't do or be in heaven, we shouldn't do or be here on earth. For example, if we won't be obsessed with money in heaven, then we shouldn't be obsessed with it here. And if we will humbly serve and put others ahead of ourselves in heaven, then we should do it here too.
