A LIFE OF PRAYER

Prayer would have to be one of the most precious gifts God has given His people in the fight against Satan and in the pursuit of Christlikeness. Daniel prayed morning, noon, and night. Christ was often found in prayer all night long. And 1 Thessalonians 5:17 tells us to “pray without ceasing.”

Just how does one “pray without ceasing”? Perhaps think of it more as practicing the presence of Christ. Imagine Christ is by your side all day, every day. There will be times of more formal prayer – eyes closed, perhaps kneeling. There will also be times when you walk together without talking, but you will also frequently drop into conversation with your Lord as the day unfolds. You may not be always talking, but you are in a continual ‘state’ of prayer.

The start of any day is a crucial time for prayer. “Every morning take time to begin your work with prayer. Do not think this wasted time; it is time that will live through eternal ages” P. 26. The time you spend in prayer now, getting to know the will of God, will be the foundation of your relationship with Him throughout eternity.

A titan of industry once told how he starts his work day with an hour of prayer. The busier and more stressful his day – the longer he prays – two or three hours! This might seem counterintuitive to people of the world, but to a Christian it brings joy and relief knowing that God is in charge and in control of our lives and outcomes. So I dare you to be a Daniel, and start praying three times a day – when prayer becomes your habit, miracles become your lifestyle.

“Don’t worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank Him for all He has done.” Philippians 4:6.
