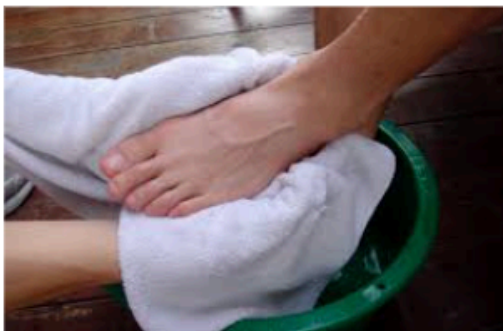

On March 7th we will start setting up the church library in the bookcase outside the Pastor's office. It will be more obvious & available to everyone incl the Sunday church.

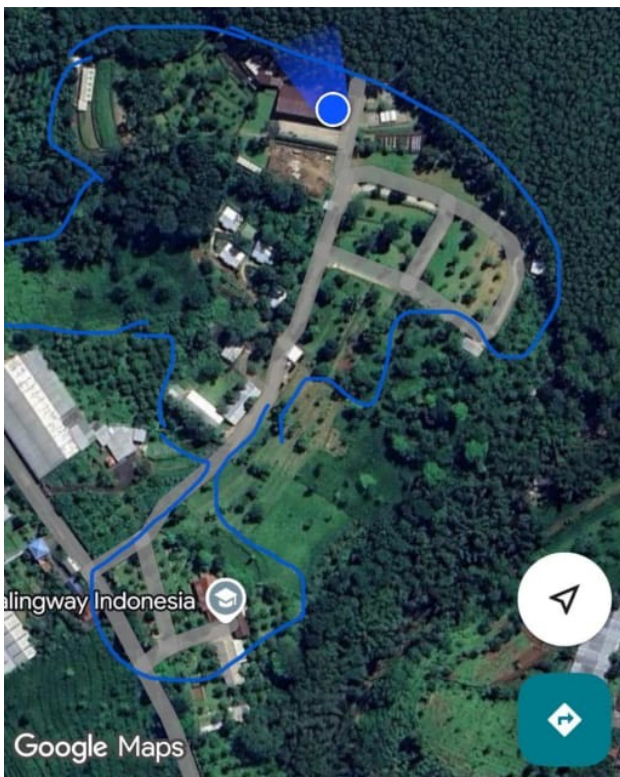
Until then we will give priority to the Sabbath School families to access the Children's Library which is in the corner room (old primary room) opposite cradle roll.

Sweet Words - Healthy Heart

Do you believe in the truism that you reap what you sow? Of course you do. Even people without common sense know it to be true. But it goes far beyond planting an apple seed and getting an apple tree. For example, if you fill your mind with dark or negative thoughts continually, then the health of your body will suffer as a result. Knowing this, the devil will keep you well supplied with things to groan and grizzle about.

When the devil seeks to vex us, he will often involve other people – thus killing two birds with one stone.
