A special highlight of the night was auntie Luna taking home the amazing auction item - the Sebel hotel package - with a winning bid of \$1200!

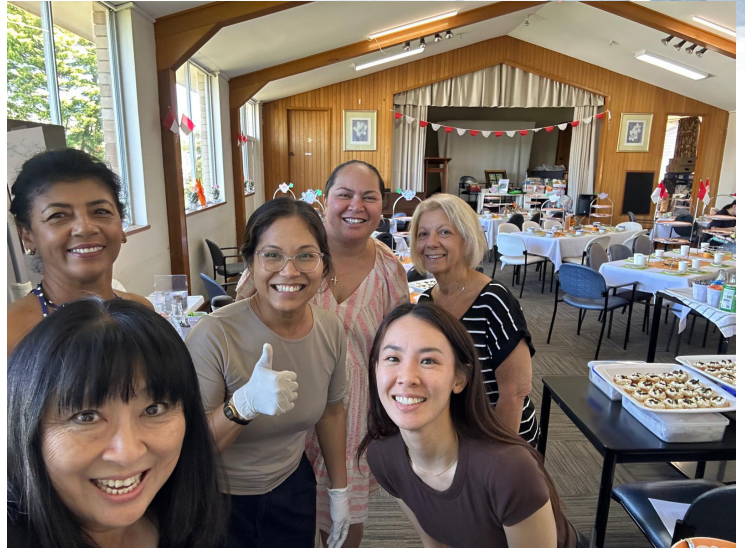

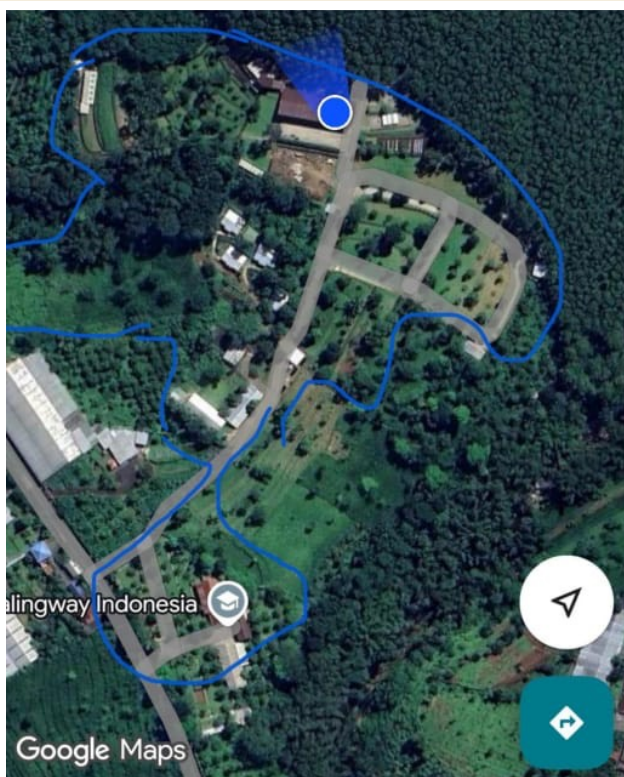

Can You See Your Mission

Imagine a worldwide pandemic that left people blind. And around the globe, for every sighted person, there were now 33 who were blind. Now imagine if you are one of the lucky sighted few. How would your life change?

- Would it be business as usual? Go to work, go to the gym, go to church, look after your family? After all, the problem is so vast, what could one person do?
- Or perhaps you are an opportunist and would make the most of the situation? You could rob people blind, and they'd never know.
- Or would your life dramatically change as you now dedicated yourself to caring for and helping the blind?

Now what if I were to tell you that this pandemic is not a hypothetical. It is real. It has happened. It is called Sin and has blinded people to the love and salvation of God. "In all the highways of life there are souls to be saved. The blind are groping in darkness. Give them the light, and God will bless you as His labourers" Ev. 553.

You were once one of the blind, until someone shared the light with you. Where is your compassion now? Are you, a sighted person, scared of the blind? Of the three options above, which path is your life following? Which path should your life be following? What are you going to do about it?

So many questions. Take your time... get it right. This is one decision you don't want to get wrong.

"You are the light of the world... let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven" Matthew 5:14-16.
